Playing Venue

The playing hall is in the University of Limerick (UL) Main Building (#3 on campus map). Only players, arbiters and HOD (in a restricted area) are permitted inside.

Next to the playing hall in the same building is a designated area for parents and visitors, the Jean Monnet Theatre. Games will be broadcast live to the internet with live commentary. These will be projected in the Jean Monnet. There are two coffee shops/ restaurants also in the same building.

Arrival at UL Campus

Please come to our ESCC 2024 “Welcome Desk” in Dromroe Village Hall (#4 on campus map). We ask each Heads of Delegation/Party to register and check-in. You will get your “welcome pack” and keys for your accommodation.

Parking is available in designated areas (see purple areas on campus map).

Accommodation

Everyone will stay in on-campus villages (#4 on campus map), which are attractive apartment style complexes. Each apartment has lockable en-suite bedrooms, a shared spacious kitchen/ living room area with a television. The kitchen is furnished with delph, cutlery, pots & pans. Some apartments have a balcony, depending on if it is above the ground floor.

All bedrooms are en-suite double bedrooms, provided with towels and toiletries (soaps, shampoo and toilet paper; no hairdryer) including a desk and sufficient storage for clothes and personal belongings.

Coin operated laundry facilities are available in Dromroe Village.

WIFI is available across the campus including the accommodation.
